Dear Friends and Family,

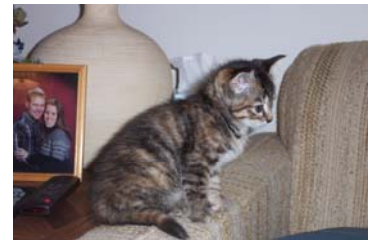
